Position overview:

We are looking for a resourceful experienced and proven organic crop farmer who can and will effectively coordinate, plan, organise and perform all farming operations in our community –we have already cleared more than 150 acres in preparation for a cover crop and need an experienced organic crop farmer to take the lead now!

Qualifications / Experience required:

You must have over 5 years of relevant experience in a similar role!

It is essential for you to have a keen interest and also extensive experience in the production and long-term storage of cultural root vegetables and tribal foods such as yams – without refrigeration.

Responsibilities include the following:

- Must plan and coordinate the production of a variety of crops, taking into consideration factors such as soil preparation, harvest taking, and environmental (organic) and market factors
- Must select and plant seeds for both food and remediation of tribal lands
- Must maintain and create optimal growing conditions, cultivation of crops and general care to ensure crop production of sufficient size to supply the community as a whole and then supply the community owned retail / general store.
- Must organise the collection, storage, and packaging of produce for both short and long term uses
- Must direct and manage general farming activities such as fertilising, pest and weed control in accordance with community and tribal guidelines.
- Responsible for maintaining farm buildings, produce storage, fences, equipment and water supply systems
- Must train and supervise in the preservation, fermentation and canning of oversupply of produce for sale in our community owned retail / general store.

- Must keep and maintain records of all farming activities
- Must plan and organise the marketing of crops, including monitoring market activity, and planning crop preparation, crop rotation, cover crops for soil preparation and production to meet contract requirements and market demand
- Must organise the sale, purchase and despatch of produce as needed in conjunction with the community needs
- Must be resourceful in the area of tool invention to assist with root crop harvesting. Experience or existing inventions would be advantageous.
- Must have experience in raising, maintenance and milking of dairy cattle and raising and maintaining poultry from chick to plate.
- Must manage business capital for farming operations including budgeting, taxation, debt and loan management
- Must have strong management skills and experience in managing a team as will be responsible for training and supervising additional staff, contractors, and volunteers including Minjungbul Tribe members and have a full comprehension of tribal sovereignty and acknowledgment of same
